There are two different types of Grants available. Tier 1,2 & 3 National Associations are eligible to apply for all wheelchair tennis players. Tier 4 National Associations can apply for junior wheelchair tennis players only (priority will be given to Tier 1,2, and 3 National Associations).

National Associations can apply for a MAXIMUM of 5 player grants (in total across Grant A and Grant B).

Grant A: *(Maximum \$2500)*

- Players should have competed in one ITF competition in last 2 years.
- Must be ranked outside of top 40 men/30 women/20 quads.
- Competition selected should be ITF3/Futures in same region unless prior approval has been obtained.

Grant B: *(Maximum \$5,000)*

- Players must have an ITF Wheelchair Tennis Ranking
- Players must have competed in at least 4 ITF events since January 2022.
- Players should have participated in regional tournaments and team events for their country in previous years where possible.
- Must be ranked outside of top 20 men/20 women and 15 quads.
- One grant prioritised for junior players.

If you are selected to receive an ITF Wheelchair Tennis Player Grant, you will be required to enter into a legally binding agreement with the ITF setting out the terms and conditions upon which the ITF shall award that Grant to you.

Please note the award of an ITF Wheelchair Tennis Player Grant is personal and not transferable.

Terms and Conditions for submitting an application

1. Use of Player Grant

If awarded:

- The grant will be used solely towards achieving your wheelchair tennis goals and objectives described in this application form, and only by you and your National Association, and under no circumstances shall it be used for any other purpose.
- you shall use your best endeavours to meet your objectives and goals outlined in the proposal above.
- your use of the Grant monies will comply with any specifications agreed with the ITF.

3. Gifts

- No gift may be made, and no advantage or benefit (direct or indirect) promised or provided to any ITF Board member, relevant Committee or Commission member, or ITF staff member that is intended or may reasonably be construed as being intended to influence the recipient to make decisions other than in the best interests of the ITF.

4. General

In submitting an application, an applicant agrees that:

- The ITF shall be entitled to terminate the application process, withdraw from any negotiations, or extend the application process in order to seek additional applications, at any time in its sole discretion.
- The ITF shall judge all applications applying such criteria as it sees fit and shall have sole discretion as to any decision or decisions which it reaches. The ITF shall not be obliged to make any award in respect of the Wheelchair Tennis Player Grant should it choose not to do so, nor to enter into correspondence with applicants.
- Applicants must treat all applications, the application process, and all related correspondence as confidential.
- The material shared as part of the application process is not intended to constitute formal agreement between the ITF and the applicant. A successful applicant will be required to agree to contractual terms which are acceptable to the ITF, as well as itself.
- Without the prior written approval of the ITF, applicants shall not make public statements in relation to any application, the application process or any termination or conclusion of or exclusion from the process.
- The ITF bear no liability in respect of any loss or damage (whether direct or indirect) suffered by the applicant in relation to this application process.
- The application process, including the award of a successful application shall be governed by and subject to the laws of England and Wales.
